

CASE STUDY:

HV BOWEN & SONS TAKES DELIVERY OF NEW TEREX FINLAY J-1160 AND 683 INCLINED SCREENER

SITUATION:

HV Bowen & Sons operate a gritstone quarry, near Welshpool in the heart of Mid Wales.

The company celebrated its centenary back in 2007, and is a family-owned business, run by Haydn Bowen and his son Mark.

It employs 31 people from the local area.

Recently, they moved into new markets - recycling construction and demolition waste in their fully licensed Recycling Centre at the Tan-y-Foel Quarry site.

SOLUTION:

Finlay Plant Central – part of the Finlay Group of companies – has supplied HV Bowen with a new Terex Finlay J-1160 Jaw Crusher and 683 Supertrak three-way screener, the investment being supported by a grant from WRAP Cymru.

Tan-y-Foel is a high psv (+68) quarry. The new machinery is being used to produce recycled aggregate from demolition and

construction waste arisings from mid-Wales and the surrounding area, leaving the gritstone reserves to be more appropriately used in higher specification materials. The recycled aggregate can also be incorporated into Tan-y-Foel's concrete batching plant.



HV Bowen felt that the Terex Finlay J-1160 jaw crusher was strong enough to cope with high throughput, yet compact enough to travel to local demolition sites for on-site crushing should the need arise. The Terex Finlay 683 Supertrak was chosen due to its compatibility with the jaw crusher, high throughput and tonnage levels, and its ease of mobility.

The quality and effectiveness of the dust

suppression equipment on both machines was also an important factor for both Haydn and Mark when specifying the plant's desired capabilities.

OUTCOME:

Mark Bowen of HV Bowen & Sons, said: "After having previous dealings with Finlay Plant Central, we were confident the new plant had the build quality, reliability and back-up required to fulfill our requirements.

"We already have a Terex Finlay 595 Hydratrak, supplied by Finlay Plant Central, which is used to screen quarry stone, and have always found the service and after-sales support to be excellent."
